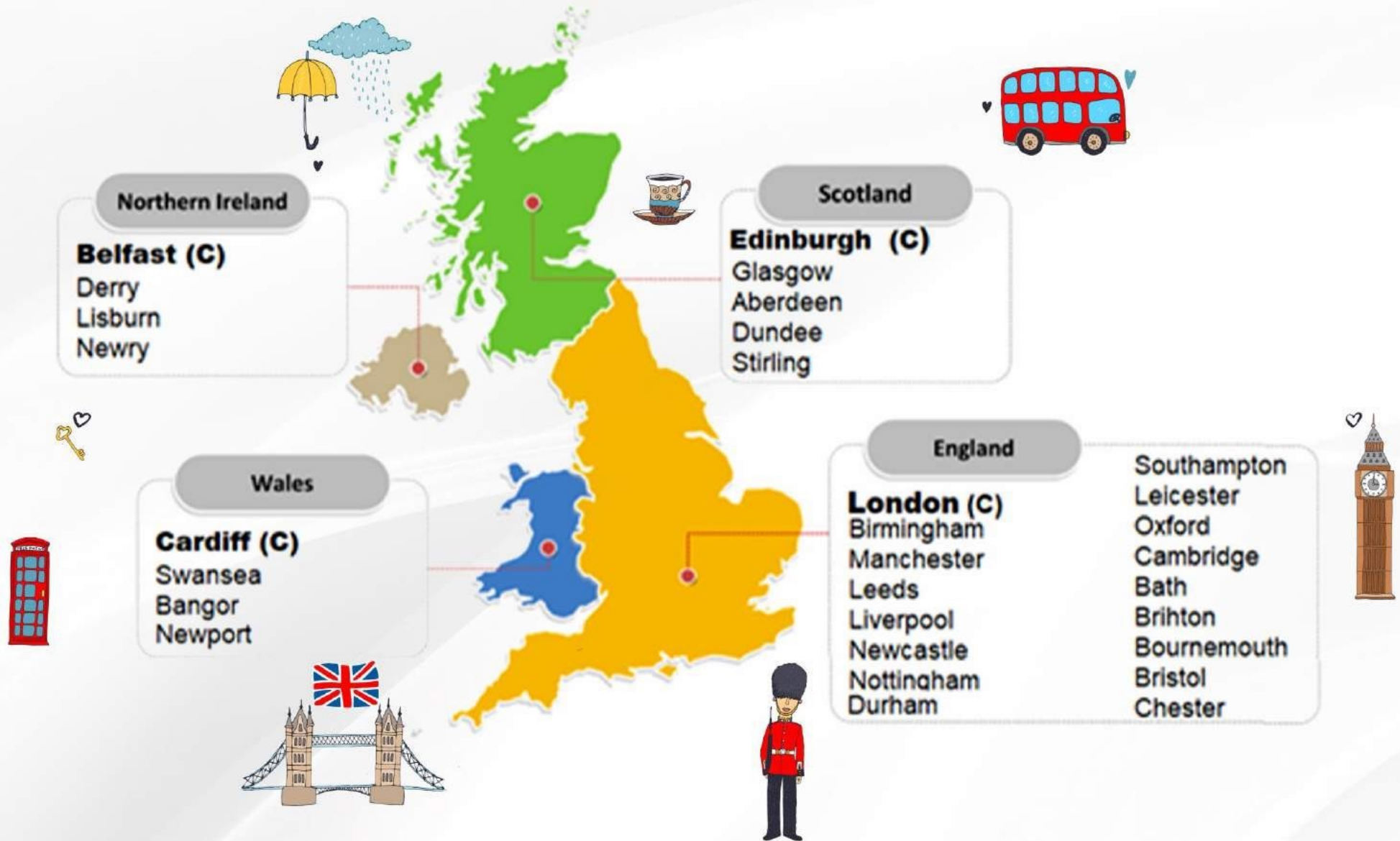


MYTHS ABOUT STUDY IN UK

TUITION FEES, ACADEMIC REQUIREMENT, ENGLISH REQUIREMENT & STAY BACK

 **Tuition Fees:** Ranges between Min 8000 GBP to Max 25000 GBP

 **Academic Requirements:** Min 55% for master's & 60% for Bachelors
Note: If scores are below required marks student can opt for Pathway Programs

 **English Requirements:** IELTS Overall 6.5 Accepted in all Universities
(Few Universities waive IELTS based on 12th English Score/MOI/University English Test)

Note: GRE is not required for UK

 **Stay Back:** Student can stay up to 24 months after Graduation

PART TIME

- **Limit:** 20 hrs/Week - Study Period ; 40hrs/week - Holidays
- **Wages:** Part Time Job Wages ranges between 7 GBP to 9 GBP/hr
- **Types:**
 - On Campus Jobs: Library, cafeteria, admission office, Tutor Assistant, student ambassador, etc.
 - Off Campus Jobs: Residential Coordinator, Food Chain, Call centre, Groceries, shopping malls, off licence shops etc.
 - Freelancing Contractual Jobs



LIVING EXPENSE CALCULATION

Accommodation	200 GBP - 800 GBP/Month
Food	100 GBP - 200 GBP/Month
Travel	50 GBP - 100 GBP/Month
Miscellaneous Expenses	50 GBP - 200 GBP/Month
Overall	400 GBP - 1300 GBP/Month

Note: The expenses incurred will be based on the student lifestyle



POST STUDY WORK OPPORTUNITIES



UNITED KINGDOM

- Stay upto 24 Months after course completion to find a job
- Student can apply for Tier 5 Temporary Worker GAE Visa & can stay upto 24 Additional Months
- Student can apply for Start Up Visa to stay upto 24 months & can switch to Innovator Visa



NETHERLANDS

- If students University/ Subject ranks top 200 world Ranking (ie THE/QS/Shanghai Ranking) they are eligible to apply 1 year Job Search Visa



CANADA

- Post Completion of course in UK, student can try for Express Entry Visa



AUSTRALIA

- Based on student previous work experience can apply for Skilled Independent Visa

NOTE:

Post Completion of Course student will have more opportunities to get job in UK, Middle East & India with very good pay scale

PERMANENT RESIDENCE (INDEFINITE LEAVE TO REMAIN)

- ▶ Student Have to stay for 5 Years on Tier 2 Visa (Work Visa) to be eligible for PR
- ▶ Student have to stay for 10 Years on Tier 4 (Study Visa) to be eligible for PR
- ▶ Student Have to extend Start-up Visa to Innovator visa & stay for 3 Years to be eligible for PR

Note:

UK Have approx. 50000 Sponsored Companies where student can apply for full time Job

VISA FUNDS REQUIREMENT & SOURCE

Visa Funds = Outstanding Tuition Fees + Living Expense

Note : Inner London = 12006 GBP,

Outer London = 9207GBP has to be shown for financials

- Self / Parents = Visa funds need to be 28 Days older in Account
- Fixed Deposit (Self / Parents) = Visa funds need to be 28 Days older in Account
- Education Loan



OFFER LETTER TURN AROUND TIME:

- Usually it takes min 24 hours to 15 working Days from day of application submission

VISA DECISION TIME:

- Super Priority Visa Takes 24 working hrs.
- Priority Visa takes 5 working Days
- Normal Visa takes normally 15 to 30 working days
